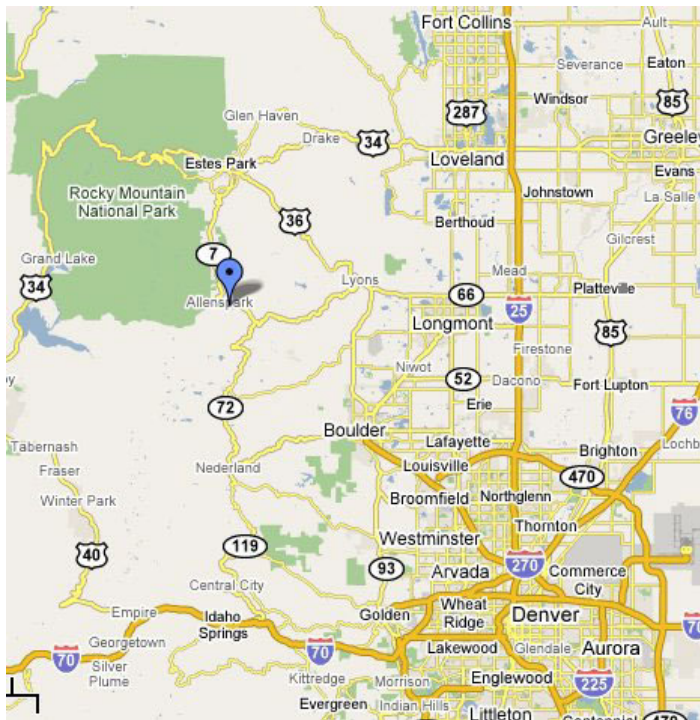
Highlands Presbyterian Camp and Retreat Center encompasses 285 acres, has 42 buildings, horse facilities, a low-elements challenge course, and access to the wilderness areas of the Roosevelt National Forest and Rocky Mountain National Park.

There are no phones or televisions in the room and cell phones do not work at Highlands; however, there is a courtesy phone in the lobby and free wireless internet access available in the dining halls and some of the west wing of the Retreat Center. There is a phone in our lobby for guests to use for local and long-distance calling within the United States at no additional charge.

Linens are provided for your convenience in the Retreat Center. You will find your bed linens folded neatly in the room. The beds in many of our rooms are graced with beautiful handmade quilts; sewn and donated by quilters who love Highlands. The bathrooms have towels and washcloths as well. In order to keep costs minimal, we ask that guests make their own beds upon arrival and, at the end of their visits, remove sheets and pillowcase from beds.

Every bedroom has its own bathroom, with the sinks and mirrors, shower, and toilet areas all separate.

From Ft. Collins and the northeast plains:

Starting at I-25, proceed south to Longmont, exit 243 and turn west on CO Hwy 66 toward Longmont/Lyons. Proceed west on 66 through Lyons to the stop sign and turn left on CO Hwy 7 toward Allenspark. Approximately 18 miles beyond Lyons, watch for signs directing travelers to turn left on the Hwy 7 business route to Ferncliff/Allenspark. Turn left on Hwy 7 business route, and proceed about 1/8 mile just past the large rock. The sign marking the entryway to Highlands is on the left.

Start your day with a hot breakfast or a selection of cereals and yogurt at our breakfast bar.

Then, at lunch and dinner, enjoy our fresh salad bar and a variety of freshly prepared entrees and desserts.

Highlands has a no alcohol policy. Exceptions to this policy are made only after an alcohol exception has been requested and approved by a review committee. ***(I have requested a waiver so we can have our "happy hour" and it HAS been approved.)***

Groups frequently ask if they may provide their own snacks. Here are our snack guidelines:

- Beverages are available throughout your stay. Our beverage bar offers a selection of juices, regular and decaf coffee, teas, and hot chocolate.
- No food preparation is permitted in the meeting rooms, and use of appliances that require an electrical supply (i.e. coffee pots, slow cookers, etc) is **not** permitted.
- All snacks must be non-perishable. No foods requiring preparation, refrigeration or heating are permitted unless food is properly stored and served in a housekeeping cabin.

- Non-perishable, purchased snack foods and beverages that do not require refrigeration or heating are permitted in the retreat center meeting rooms.
- Approved snacks include: pretzels, chips, crackers, popcorn, peanuts, candy, whole fruit, soda, and bottled water.
- All incidental items, including paper plates, napkins, and cups should be provided for by you.

DINING ROOM SET UP: In order to minimize your costs, guests are expected to help in clean up after each meal by returning their dishes to the dish room and wiping down their tables in the dining room that they use.

CLEAN UP: Retreat Center: On your last day, please strip your beds, put all soiled linens & towels in pillow cases and place them outside the bedroom door.

No smoking is permitted in buildings. Additionally, smoking is strongly discouraged on site. If there is a need to smoke outside, please utilize the gray receptacles located at the west and northeast Retreat Center exits.

Food is NOT permitted in sleeping areas of the Retreat Center. Non-perishable, purchased snacks and beverages that do not require refrigeration or heating are permitted in the retreat center meeting rooms. We are out in the "wild" and don't want to encourage any of those little creatures to visit us indoors. ***There are no microwaves or refrigerators in the sleeping rooms.*** You may have an ice chest for your soft and harder drinks.

Copy Machine/Fax: Available during office hours. Cost is \$.10 per copy/sheet.

Questions & Emergencies: If there are problems with anything in your facility, please notify one of our staff members. After hours, emergency numbers and the phone numbers of on-site staff are posted by the phone in the main lobby.

Please be aware of the cancellation policy concerning LNCQ retreats and events.

If there is no one on the wait list, then you will not receive your money back. If you *cancel before 7 PM, Sept. 17, 2017* you will get your meal fees refunded in the amount of \$84.50.

Each camper is to fill out this form individually. Do **NOT** send it in with anyone else's. After all of the campers are registered, you will be sent the list of names of those wanting to share a quad room. It will be up to YOU to decide on roommates/suitemates and then get that information to Sissy. If you do not have a preference, please let her know and a room will be assigned. Thank you for your cooperation with this.

Do **not** mail your registration **before** August 21, 2017: If more than 40 registrations come in on the first day, they will all be put in a hat and a drawing will take place and a wait list will be started. This is the only fair way I can come up with. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation on this.

Sharing a quad room with 3 other quilters is \$230.00 (shared bath)
Quad room having 1/2 to yourself is \$350.00 each (shared bath) There would be either 1 or 2 others sharing this space.
Completely private single room is \$460.00
