Supply List for Wacky Bird Take Away Appliqué Workshop

Basic sewing supplies including:

- Scissors for cutting fabric
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Several sheets of **lined notebook paper** at least 8" x 11" in size
- Scotch tape
- Straight pins
- Needles for embroidery and applique
- Regular pencil
- Fabric marking pencil
- Embroidery floss that compliments and contrasts with your fabrics
- Sewing thread to match applique fabrics
- A piece of **foam board** approximately 8" x 10" in size

Fabrics:

- 11" square of background fabric;
- Fat quarters or scraps of fabric for bird feet, beak, body, wings, small pieces for twigs and leaves
- The patterns will be provided at class.
