Barn Quilt Painting Workshop with Suzi Parron

We will be painting a two-foot square quilt block on WOOD, suitable to hang outdoors!

- The workshop lasts about 4-5 hours
- This is a “NO UFO” workshop. The goal is to finish in one session—and most of you will!
- Note that we are using exterior paint---the quilt block will be weather ready.



Supplies provided:

- ~Pre-primed 2 by 2 foot board. The priming is a two-day job, which is already done for you
- ~Suggested patterns ready to transfer (you may bring your own, but keep it simple— and be ready to draw it onto the board)
- ~Exterior latex paint, which can be mixed for your choice of colors
- ~Foam brushes
- ~ Knives for cutting tape

Supply List:

- Painter’s tape—Green (NOT YELLOW) “Frog” brand is BY FAR the best, but blue Scotch tape will do. Narrower tape (about 1 inch) is preferred
- Yardstick or 24 inch ruler
- Pencil
- Blow dryer with extension cord for every 2-3 people
- Coverings for tables (host organization usually provides)



Note that we will be painting. It is not super messy, but there is some chance you will get paint on your clothing. Dress accordingly or bring an apron!

Choose your pattern. Note that colors are just for illustration.

Row 1 = easiest; Row 2=easy; Row 3= intermediate; Row 4=challenging
