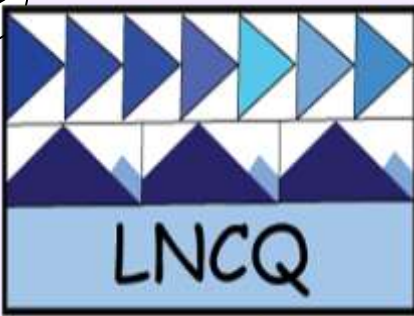

Upon completion of the the quilting the quilt will be collected by the Community Service Chairperson or a committee member and someone that has volunteered to bind charity quilts will be contacted.

Upon completion of the binding the quilt will be given to the Community Service Chairperson for distribution.

The person making the quilt top will not have it returned to them.

Members who wish to donate a "*finished*" charity quilt may do so at a general meeting or by contacting the Community Service Chair or a committee member.

LNCQ is only accepting baby, child and quilts up to adult lap size. Please, NO bed size quilts.

LNCQ will be having a come and sew retreat and go sleep at home in the comfort of your own bed!!

Date: Monday, January 22 and Tuesday, January 23, 2018

Time: Monday 8 to whenever (you may stay as late as you want, there will be someone there until you leave), and Tuesday 8 to 5 (firm, a church activity to follow)

Location: First United Methodist Church 533 Grant Avenue, Loveland, Colorado

Price: \$25 for 2 days, please note, as with all LNCQ activities this is non-refundable

This building is handicap accessible with a restroom nearby and a full kitchen. The building has good security, parking lot lighting and we can lock ourselves in!

Irons, ironing boards, cutting tables and cutting boards will be provided. Please do not bring small irons for set up at your tables as the electric will not handle these.

You will share an 8 foot table and they will be set up in pods of four. You are welcome to bring your own comfy chairs. You will need to bring all your own quilting supplies except where noted. I have also attached a list of "Retreat Supplies" for your convenience. Auxiliary lighting is highly recommended as the lighting is not the best.

Everyone will be responsible for their own food for the 2 days. Coffee, hot water and tea will be provided. Jayne Cooley will have a list of nearby restaurants with phone numbers and information on delivery so you can either go out/pickup/deliver or you can bring your own food. You are welcome to bring a snack to share.

Please remember as with all LNCQ activities, we ask that you do not wear perfume as we have so many people who are allergic, we do not talk politics or religion.

Registration starts December 4th at the Christmas Party. PLEASE MAKE OUT TWO SEPARATE CHECKS FOR 2018 MEMBERSHIP AND THE RETREAT. Both checks will need to be made out to LNCQ. We will have two separate tables set up at the Christmas Party. I have attached the 2018 Membership form and the Retreat form so you can fill them out before you come. Also attached is a list of the many activities LNCQ will have in 2018.
